GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION

(GDPR) May 2018. Data protection in the UK is changing in May 2018 and the new law gives individuals (you and me) more rights over how information about them is stored and used by organisations including our diocese and parishes. In particular, organisations have to tell individuals what they are doing with information they are storing and processing. If you work or volunteer for the parish or diocese, framework or other ministry group and collect, use and store information about people this DOES apply to you. Training is being offered for parish staff and groups and the Diocese will offer the information that all parishes and groups need in order to comply with the new legislation and keep our data safe.

FLU You will have been aware in the news that GPs and hospitals are now seeing very high rates of patients with flu and in some case serious and life-threatening complications. The health department are asking people to take reasonable steps to prevent the spread of this illness. To this end and for the time being the sign of peace will not be offered during Mass. If you suffer from a cold or have flu like symptoms please do not partake of the chalice.
