### NEW GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION

The GDPR comes into force on the 25<sup>th</sup> May 2018 and will impact every organisation which holds or processes personal data. The diocese in conjunction with parishes and curial offices are now in the process of revising processes to ensure that we are compliant. The diocese is committed to ensuring high standards of information security, privacy and transparency.

## CAFOD'S NEW CAMPAIGN: "SHARE THE JOURNEY":

During a mass in Rome that was attended by 6000 poor and homeless people in November 2017, the Holy Father said that, in response to human suffering: "God will not ask us if we felt righteous indignation, but whether we did some good." More people than ever before have been forced from their homes by war, disasters and poverty. This coming September, leaders will gather at the United Nations to agree how to help them and Pope Francis wants to show them the way. Migrants and refugees, Pope Francis said, "are no different to our own family and friends. Each of them has a name, a face and a story, as well as a right to live in peace and to aspire to a better future for their sons and daughters. Christ asks us to welcome our migrant and refugee Brothers and Sisters with arms open wide". The Pope has called Catholics around the world to join his global campaign, "**SHARE THE JOURNEY**". He wants us to play our part in protecting people on the move and giving them hope for the future. Will you show your support for refugees and join Pope Francis's campaign? **At Our lady Queen of Peace we will join Pope Francis's campaign on Saturday 9th June and walk in solidarity with our global neighbours.** We intend to start our walk after the 10.30am mass. Will you join us to show you care about the millions of people - 20 every minute - forced to flee their homes and make desperate journeys in search of refuge and to show world leaders meeting next September how much it matters to all of us that refugees and migrants are treated with dignity and respect? 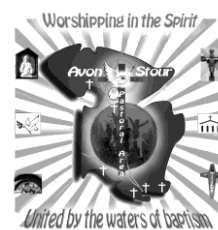
